

Suspension of Service of Temperature Measurement Stations

1. In view of the stabilization of the COVID-19 epidemic in Taiwan, the university will suspend the service of temperature measurement stations on campus, starting Monday, May 25. The entrance control of campus buildings is also lifted, subject to the management of the individual buildings. Faculty, staffs, and students of the university are still required to observe personal health and maintain social distance. For those who have fever or upper respiratory tract symptoms, please stay at home, away from public and campus. Other anti-epidemic measures that restrict access from general public, such as those imposed by the libraries, sports facilities, etc., are still in effect for the time being.
2. Please follow particularly the following anti-epidemic practices:
 - (1) Maintain social distance: Please maintain a social distance of 1.5 meters indoors and 1 meter outdoor. When social distance cannot be maintained, please wear a physician mask, separate seats with partitions, or keep a diamond-shaped seating to maintain an appropriate safety distance.
 - (2) Maintain sanitation: Take body temperature daily and keep hands clean at all times. Business facilities, whether indoors or outdoors, should take body temperature and provide dry or wet hand-washing supplies at entrances.
 - (3) Keep records of presence of personnel, implement human flow control, and keep environmental sanitation.
3. As long as the above guidelines are followed, restrictions on number of participants to large-scale activities, i.e., 100 people indoors and 500 people outdoor, can be lifted.
4. The university has provided temperature measurement service on campus for nearly three months. The efforts of all the staffs and students who participate in the service to keep our campus safe are greatly appreciated.
